on September 21 – 22, 2023

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INTRODUCTION OF WP1

- The aim of WP1 is for the partners from 6 different countries to collect:
 - 5 good practices implemented in their country for pupils with speech and language problems.
 - Information about the legal framework of each country where the good practices are applied.

By collecting the good practices, the partners will get to know the language and speech support systems implemented in these countries. Their analysis will also help the partners to understand the content and methodology which will be developed in the framework of the SLTools project.

The implementation framework of these good practices, methodologies and results will be used and exploited for the development of online speech and language support tools (SL TOOLS) in WP2.

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IMPLEMENTATION STAGES FOR THE FINAL REPORT ON SPEECH AND LANGUAGE TOOLS SUPPORT SYSTEMS

1. Create a common format that will be used to collect information. This form will include a short presentation of each practice, methodology, indicative activities, duration and main findings (weaknesses - opportunities, innovative approaches regarding speech and language support systems).

2. Collection of 5 good practices implemented both in the partner countries and from other European countries not participating in the programme.

3. The task of each participating country is to summarise in a report all good practices according to the common template provided by the lead partner of WP1. The report should be translated into English in order to facilitate the transmission and dissemination of good practices to all European countries.

4. The ASD lead partner will collect all the transnational reports and summarize them in a transnational report presenting the general conclusions and a summary of the results at European level. The draft transnational report will be shared with all partners for comment or further improvement. The ASD will then finalize the last version of the transnational report. A summary of the transnational report will be shared with partners so that it can be translated and disseminated on blogs, forums, presentations and any other place where the results of WP1 can be communicated.



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RESULTS OF THE MEETING IN FRANCE

Launch of the 1st international in-person meeting, organized by Interactive 4D in Nice, France on 21-22 September 2023. The two-day meeting provided an overview of the project, clarifying information on the project's progress and ways to disseminate WP1 results. In addition, a good practice was presented by each partner and the partner in charge of WP1 presented to us the progress of the project. Finally, the next online meeting, the closure of WP1 and the 2nd face-to-face meeting in Ireland were decided and scheduled.
